

The Ten Commandments

On it you shall not do any work, you, or your son, or your daughter, your male servant, or your female servant, or your livestock, or the sojourner who is within your gates. For in six days the LORD/YHWH made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested on the seventh day. Therefore the LORD/YHWH blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.

ning, morning and noon.


(You are) The Beneficent One—for Your kindness




The LORD/YHWH's Prayer
